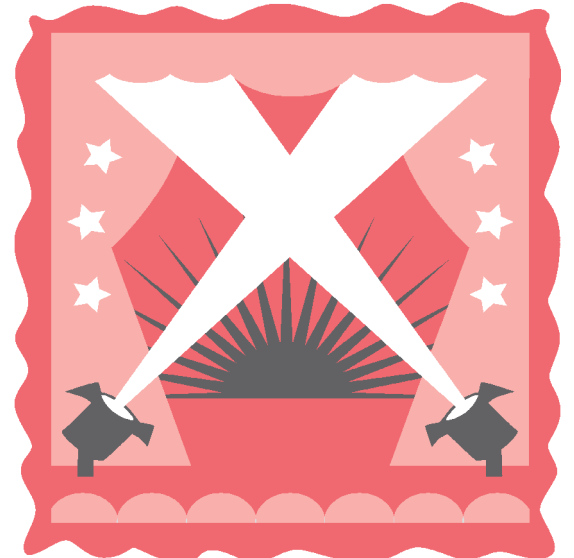

Note: Registration begins in December. District residents may register for one or more workshops beginning Monday, December 21 at 10 am & 7 pm.

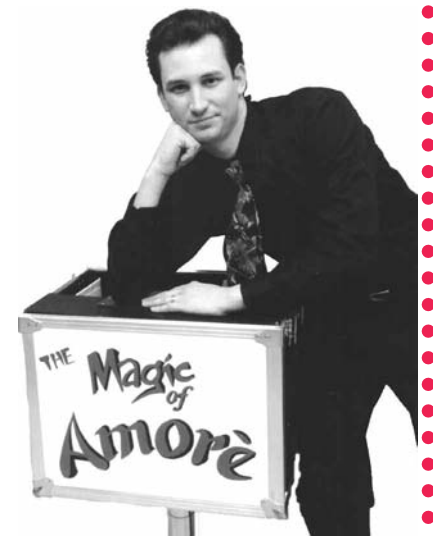


The Wizard's Magic Workshops with Amore

10 to 10:30 am or 11 to 11:30 am

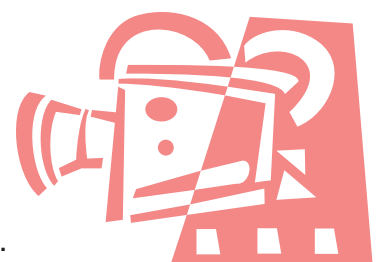
This early childhood music program includes singing, movement and instrument play specifically designed for babies through preschool and the grownups who love them. Join us for one of these classes.

Ask us about the NEW "Live Homework Help"

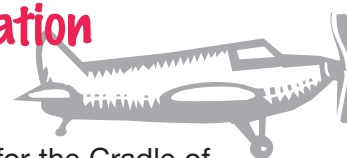
Use in the library or at home!

Your Hewlett-Woodmere Library Card — Your Ticket of Admission

Unless tickets have been distributed, your Hewlett-Woodmere Public Library card is your "ticket of admission" for priority seating at Library programs. Only Hewlett-Woodmere Union Free School District residents will be seated until five minutes before the start of any program. At that time non-residents may be seated if space remains and at the discretion of the Librarian or Friend in charge of the program.

Members of the Friends of the Library who are not Hewlett-Woodmere Public Library cardholders will be eligible for tickets to programs sponsored by the Friends of the Library. Please have your Friends' membership card ready.
