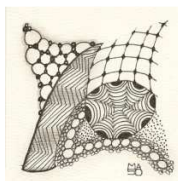
DECORATIVE CD/DVD HOLDER

GHOSTS, GHOULS, AND MONSTERS OF LONG ISLAND

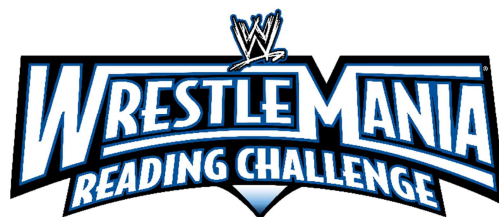
