

Nassau & Suffolk County Law Libraries Offer Free Services to All

There are 3 county law libraries that are open to the public & provide a number of free services.

Co-located within the library is the **Court Information Center**, which has 5 public computers with access to the internet, *Lexis*, & several Do-It-Yourself forms. Photocopy machines are available at 10cents per page. In addition, the library has a public access digital scanner. The staff can answer procedural questions, provide sample court forms, & instructional packets. They can be reached at (516) 571-3291.

There are 2 law libraries in Suffolk County that are also open to the public & provide free services, including the Library Resources for the Public Program (LRPP).

The LRPP is available to provide free general information about court procedural steps. Located inside the Supreme Court Law Library, in both Central Islip & Riverhead, are computers with internet access & printers, as well as personnel who can assist & provide legal resources for researching your case. Both libraries offer free access to *Lexis*, along with N.Y.S. & Federal hard copy collections. Photocopy machines are available for 10cents per page.

The LRPP is currently a walk-in service, however, appointments are preferred & may be scheduled by calling the appropriate location listed above.
